Subject: Smoke onboard APL VANCOUVER 302W- Preliminary Notice

We regret to inform you that vessel APL VANCOUVER 302W reported smoke in her cargo hold on 31 Jan 2019 en route from Shekou to Singapore. Source of the fire is unknown, and no dangerous cargo has been loaded in the cargo hold as per the stowage information.

The latest information from APL on Feb.3 says that APL Vancouver still has signs of fire aboard and firefighting action is continuing. The vessel is being attended by the Vietnamese MRCC (Maritime Rescue Coordinating Center), fire fighters, firefighting tugs and a salvage master. APL Vancouver remains at anchorage off the Vietnamese coast. APL cannot confirm which containers are involved nor the condition of containers and cargo onboard the vessel.

We will keep you updated once further information is available.
